Identity-Access Management (I-AM) Goals

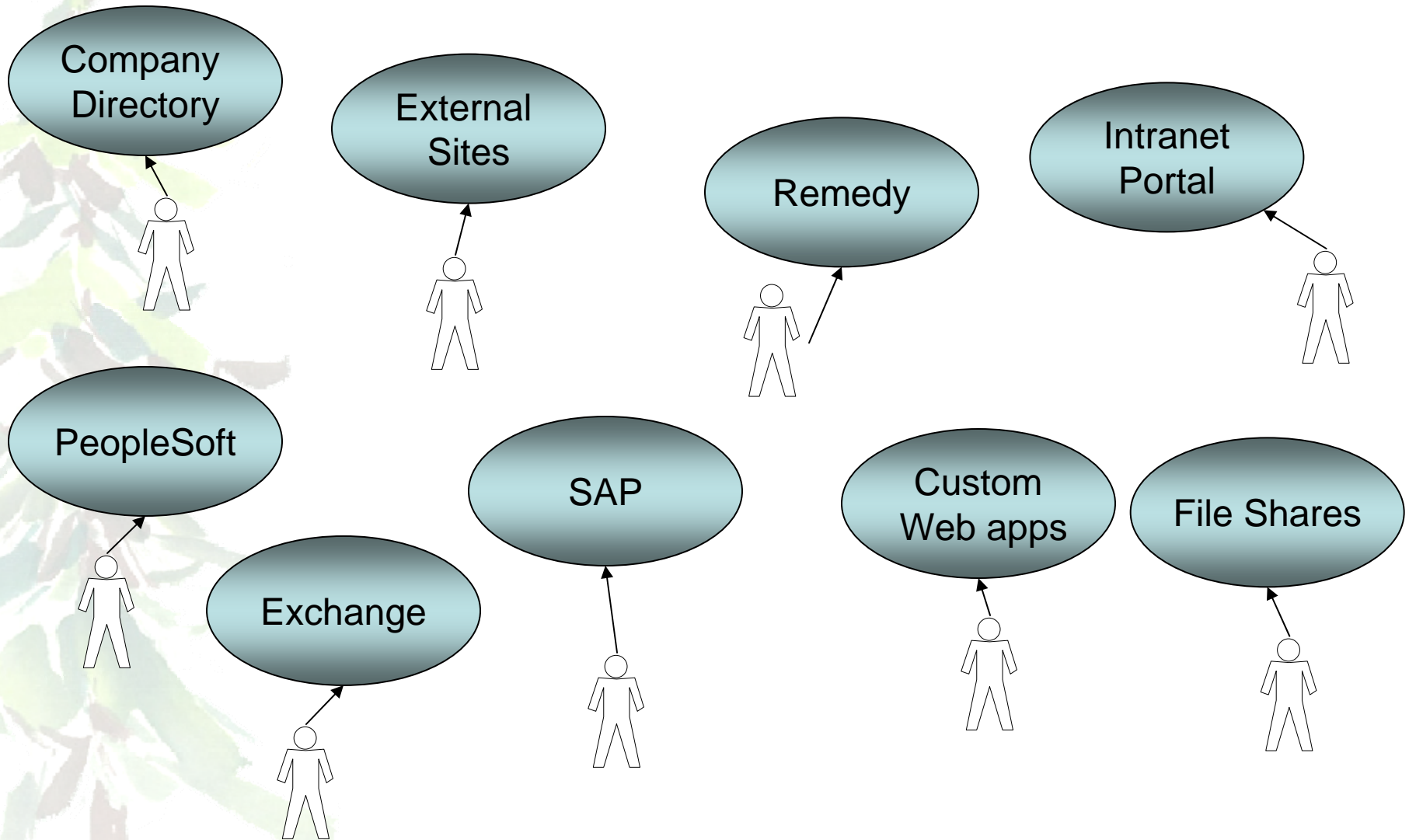
- Automate processes to:
 - Approve/grant access to applications
 - Revoke access in a timely manner
- Ensure user information is consistent across the Company



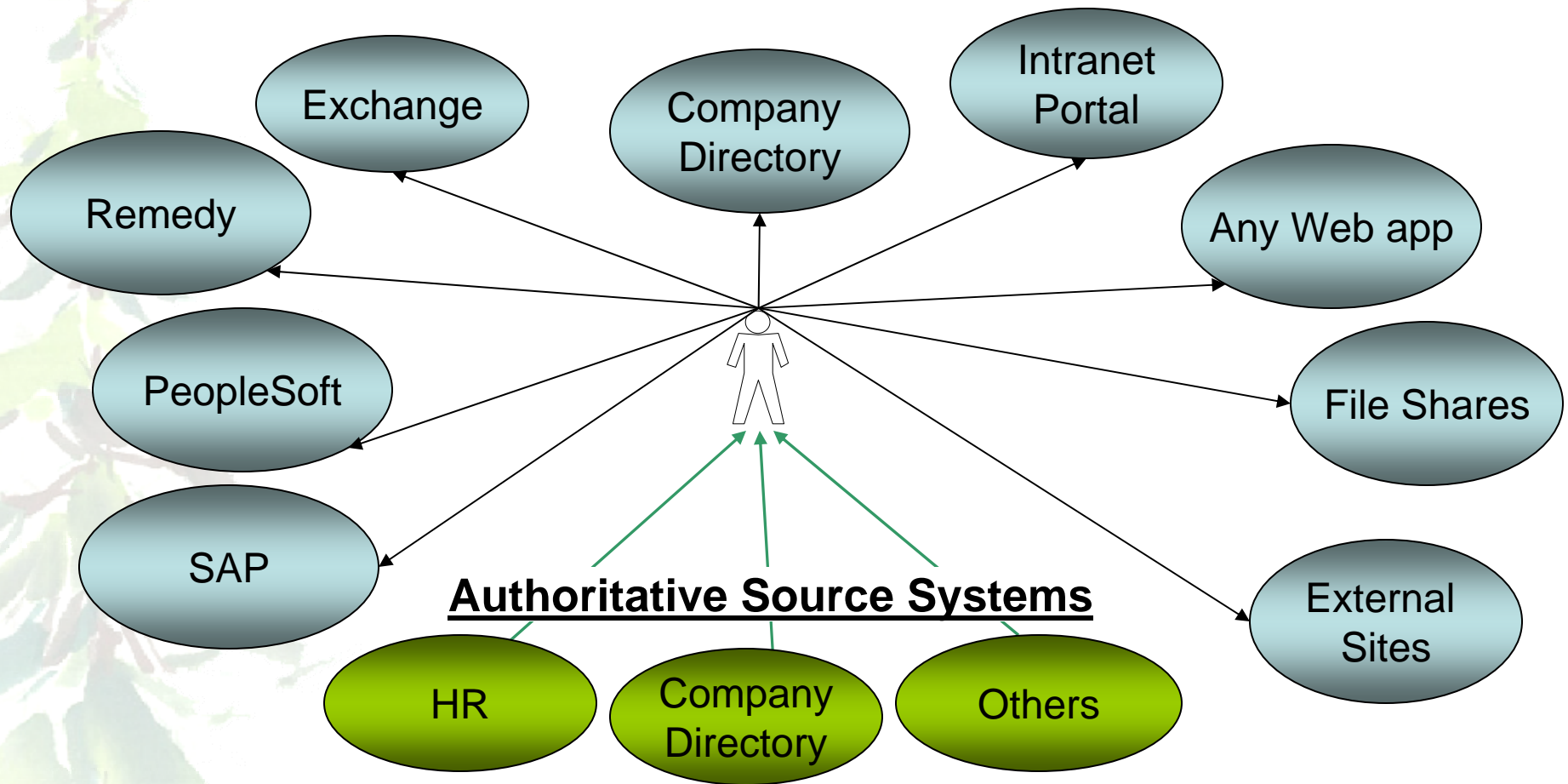
Access Management-specific Goals

- Reduce the number of:
 - Login accounts people must use, hopefully to one
 - Times a person must enter their user name and password for web applications
- Adhere to SOX and IT Security policies

IAM Keys to Success

- Understand the business process being automated
- Involve key stakeholders early and set expectations
- Invest in change management (critical)
- Look for quick wins
- Plan for a phased approach
